John Staples Clinic

When I heard the rumor that John Staples might be coming to town, I sat up and paid attention. Sure, it was the end of the year, I was tired and broke from horse shows and clinics, but I was NOT going to miss a lesson from this guy. My best friend who got me started in the crazy sport of eventing could not say ENOUGH good things about John Staples, "He helped my riding more than anyone", and "my daughter has become a very confident rider with his instruction!"

So when the Timber Ridge Pony Club recruited him to come to Bill Coester's Winds Reach Farm on November 6th, 2010, I was there, along with my not-so-inspired mount Teddy. It was chilly, but comfortable enough in Bill's huge arena, and the pony club moms had brought hot soup and sandwiches and all kinds of delicious food.

We had a flat lesson on Saturday and a group jumping lesson on Sunday. When you've had as many flat lessons as I have, it's harder to get excited about another one. But John delivered as my friend promised – taking a fundamental riding basic and making it new and inspiring. His big stress was Rider Balance – it's amazing how many times you lose your balance at the trot. Our first exercise was at the posting trot – stay UP 2 beats and DOWN 1 beat, UP 2 beats, DOWN 1 beat. Harder than it sounds, it smacks you in the face with how important your balance really is, and how you (I) must take more responsibility for it every moment.

Bending at the trot – put your inside leg on FIRST, then turn with your outside leg. Another exercise – trot, collect the trot, extend the trot – letting the horse move to the bit (don't lose the contact) and collect the trot again. Sure, we've all done this, but this was more precise and demanding. I asked John about how Teddy wanted to pay attention to everything but me, and he said "We want the horse truly on the aids – then he will not spook or pay attention to other stuff." As I collected and extended and collected and extended, Teddy became more and more focused on me. This is an exercise that I need to use a LOT more.

We did a few more exercises with poles on the ground (four poles in a square) and we trotted and then cantered square corners. Another one to practice at home! Sunday's lesson was fantastic – grid work jumping, focusing on pace and straightness. Teddy was behind my leg, and jumping like a slow cow, so we worked on

keeping him up and moving and the jumps took care of themselves. I got to watch the prelim group lesson – fantastic stuff!

Thank you to the Pony Club for organizing this clinic, and special thanks to Bill Coester for providing his wonderful facility. Bill said about the clinic: "John was able to put together exercises both in the flat work and over fences that stressed the basics of balance and carriage in the horse which improved overall rideability and made it fun."

Finances

Jan Vlasak pointed out that with the 3 year memberships we need to hold money in reserve for future USDF GMO dues. The USDF only charges the dues once a year. Perhaps there is a way this money can be earmarked. Can Jan let Lois know how much we need to hold per year? Can it be shown in future Treasurers reports? Lois submitted report. Membership

About 15 members have not renewed their membership yet. We discussed calling them. The invoices that Jan sends out each year are very helpful. (Thanks Jan!)

Discussion on the EIDEA Yahoo group list. We are unsure how many members are on the list – 50% maybe? Members who are not on Yahoo do not get email notifications. This probably has

an impact on meeting attendance. Judy Nauseef will contact Yahoo Group members to ask them to identify who belongs to what email addresses so that we can have a list of who is on YaHoo and who is not. No decision was made on how to get more members to sign up for Yahoo. Some members are opposed to these types of services. No decisions on how alternative notification.

Meeting Participation

We discussed ways to increase member participation in planning and at meetings. Megan Ward suggested asking new members those not present what it would take to them get involved. Would a survey help find out what members want from EIDEA? Deb Levine thought it would be better to talk one on one then have a printed survey. It was noted that as always our demonstrations have the biggest draw. We do need to spread out the locations of meetings. We have a large territory with members that have to drive over an hour to get to a meeting.

This year the Planning session and Awards Banquet were relatively small compared to previous years. Although small, it was also noted that they were very fun. Reasons for the small turnout to the November Awards Banquet were thought to be - Election night, choice of restaurant versus potluck and being on a Tuesday. Deb Levine suggested going back to Potluck and calling members for their RSVP and food assignments. Others suggested combining the Dec (which use to be Tack and Yack) and Nov meetings and having it on Friday, Nov 11th. It will be called "The End of the Season Social". There would be no Educational December meeting but would probably be reserved for a board meeting. (Also we need to figure out how to deal with EIDEA Officer elections - it is in our Bylaws that they are held at the Nov meeting.)

Volunteers

Chris Africa asked for help with Bill Coester's Wind's Reach Jump Derby / Dressage Reach show. It will be Memorial Day weekend. Deb Levine volunteered.

This led to a discussion of organizing EIDEA volunteers so local shows could call an EIDEA representative and we could help get people lined up. We created a Volunteer Coordinator position to help with participation. Deb Levine was willing to take this on. Suggestions: Ask what is in it for the members or prospective members. Buddy with a member, work together and/or come together to meetings.

We worked on 2011 meetings, leaders and locations. (Meetings through September have been confirmed.)

New Helmet Rules:

The Board of Directors during this year's United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) Annual Meeting approved **new helmet rules for riders in both eventing and dressage** - just two weeks after dozens of stakeholders in equestrian sport met with the goal of improving rider safety across disciplines.

"If the technology is available to reduce head injuries, the time to use it is now," said USEF President David O'Connor. "I am very proud of our organization for taking this very important step. It is a huge direction of change."

Briefly, the first rule change requires anyone on a horse to wear a ASTM/SEI-approved helmet at all times while mounted on competition grounds at U.S. nationally rated eventing competitions. The rule change is effective immediately.

Further specifics regarding the changes to the rule for Protective Headgear for Eventing (EV 114.1) will be posted at www.usef.org

The United States Eventing Association (USEA) helped shepherd the rule change through the USEF committees during USEF's Annual Meeting.

"The attention to safety in eventing has led to a 40 percent decrease in rider injuries between 2007 and 2011," said Malcolm Hook, USEF Eventing Safety Officer and chair of the USEF Eventing Technical Committee. "The Eventing Technical Committee could see no reason to delay implementation of a probably inevitable and statistically justifiable rule change in an effort to continue this encouraging trend."

Effective March 1, 2011: For Dressage, anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).
